What is the scale of the problem?

Every year, insurance carriers across the country are routinely inundated with millions of spreadsheets and mailed letters officially requesting policy-related changes and updates from financial institutions.

For example, Evolution Risk Advisors, one of the largest P&C insurance companies in Florida had been urgently searching for a solution for more than five years in hopes of eliminating the need to hire more staff just to manually process the mail and data entry.

Massachusetts based carrier, The Hanover Insurance group, reluctantly turned to an expensive outsourcing option overseas in an effort to mitigate the operational inefficiency of internally processing the volume of physical mailed requests and daily spreadsheets from lien holders and mortgagees.

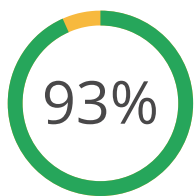

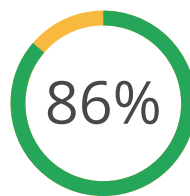

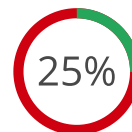
